Brief History	<p>Since 2001, various Higher Education Institutions in Chile have innovated in competency-based training, updating not only the curricula offered, but also pedagogical practices, placing special emphasis on learning the students through the development of teaching and didactics in higher education. It previous generated in the institutions the need to have Improvement Units Teacher (UMD), who thanks to the support of 24 MECESUP (Ministry of Education) projects were able to develop their Teaching-Learning Units or Center. In 2009 holds the first forum for exchanging experiences of the centers and units supporting teaching of Chile (ECAD) which constitutes a milestone in the history of academic development national.</p> <p>This seminar aimed to learn about the various advances of the Units and Centres and manage to generate contacts and alliances.</p> <p>Then the idea of creating a NETWORK raised in 2012 to formalize and create new and creative coordination modalities that allow growth. The ECAD has been developed annually, only except for the years 2019 and 2020.</p>

It has the role of preparing the guidelines of the NETWORK's strategic development plan, approve the work plans and the annual accounts of the Executive Directorate. Ensures the execution and compliance of the activities. It is made up of a representative from each educational institution affiliated superior with the right to speak and vote.</p>
